**Sub.: Participation of athletes during 73<sup>rd</sup> Men and 36<sup>th</sup> Women Senior National Weightlifting Championships-2020-21 after revision of minimum qualifying standards – Provision of WILDCARD entries.**

Dear All,


In continuation of our circular nos. IWLF-Cir./2020-21/130 dated 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2021 and IWLF-Cir./2020-21/130-R dated 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2021, it is submitted that those States who fail to qualify in any weight category in any section (men or women) will earn 2 WILD CARD ENTRIES, 1 each in men and women section for participation during 73<sup>rd</sup> Men and 36<sup>th</sup> Women Senior National Weightlifting Championships-2020-21.

**For example,**

- (i) State 'AAA' does not qualify both in men and women section, then State 'AAA' will field 1 men athlete and 1 women athlete in any body weight category specified by them, 2 wild cards cannot be used selectively for 2 men or 2 women entries.
- (ii) State "BBB" only qualifies in men section, then they will get 1 wild card entry in women section only.
- (iii) State "CCC" only qualifies in women section, then they will get 1 wild card entry in men section only.

Kindly take a note of it.
