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MINUTES OF ANNUAL GENERAL COUNCIL MEETING OF INDIAN WEIGHTLIFTING FEDERATION

held on Saturday, 21st of December, 2013 at 11:00 a.m. at Viswaratna Hotel, Guwahati, Assam.

Members Present: List appended separately.

1. Welcome: Shri B.P. Baishya, Member of Parliament, President called the House to order and welcomed dignitaries, guests and participants in the House.

The President briefed the House about achievements of Indian weightlifters and Technical officials in International events in past few years.

The President then highlighted the achievement of Indian Weightlifting Federation in yester years including the participation of Indian athletes and 1 Referee in 2012 London Olympic Games.

History created by Indian athletes during 2013 Commonwealth Youth (Boys & Girls), Junior (Men & Women) and Senior (Men & Women) Weightlifting Championships at Penang, Malaysia from 24-30 November 2013 where Indian athletes won as many as 117 medals.

ITEM NO. 1:

CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF MEETING OF SPECIAL GENERAL COUNCIL HELD AT NEW DELHI ON 4TH AUGUST, 2013:-

The Secretary General informed the House that the Minutes of General Council Meeting held at New Delhi on 4 August 2013 had been circulated to all affiliated units of Indian Weightlifting Federation. The House confirmed the receipt of the Minutes and passed the Minutes unanimously.

ITEM NO. 2: ANNUAL REPORT OF THE SECRETARY GENERAL FOR THE PERIOD 01.08.2013 TO 20.12.2013:-

The Secretary General presented his report for the period 1.8.2013 to 20.12.2013 in the House. Highlights of the report presented remarks the achievements as under:-

(i) 117 medals were won by Indian athletes in the recently concluded Commonwealth Youth, Junior & Senior Championships held at Penang, Malaysia from 24-30 November 2013.

(ii) Numerous National records were broken by Indian athletes in Youth, Junior & Senior section in the National Championships, Selection trials and International Competitions.

(iii) Conduct of Continuous National coaching camps first time in History of weightlifting for all three sections, viz., Youth, Junior & Senior.

(iv) Increase of budget by Sports Authority of India for the sport of weightlifting by 50% from earlier financial years.

Identification of athletes in Venth & Innion and

(v) Identification of athletes in Youth & Junior section – R.V. Rahul in 77 kg weight category won Gold medal during 2nd Asian Youth Games beating his compatriot Chinese weightlifter by 26 kg.

(vi) 600 random samples were collected by National Anti-Doping Agency during out-of-competition & in-competitions in 2013 and tightening of

noose on monster of doping from the sport.

(vii) 150+ dope samples collected by International Weightlifting Federation during out-of-competition & in-competitions in 2013. Not even a single positive case reported.

(viii) Participation of Indian Technical Officials in all International events held

in the years 2010, 2011, 2012 & 2013.

He expressed thanks to all the members and President for the continuous support rendered by them to the Secretary General in day to day functioning of the Federation. He particularly mentioned to the House that it was due to efforts of the President that Indian athletes participated in events which are not part of the Annual Calendar – viz., 2013 Asian Cup held at Pyongyang, DPR Korea where Indian athletes returned with numerous medals.

Shri Sunil Elangbam, General Secretary, Manipur Weightlifting Association with permission of the Chair clarified from the report of the Secretary General about actual medals at stake during the 2013 Commonwealth Championships at Penang. He further questioned regarding the number of countries participated in these Championships

The President told the House that out of possible 135 medals at stake for India, out of total 405 medals, Indian team won 117 medals in all three events viz., Snatch, Clean & Jerk and Total. 32 Commonwealth countries participated in 2013 Commonwealth Weightlifting Championships.

Shri Sunil Elangbam questioned about missing of some referees names in the report of Secretary General who are now International Category-1 Referees with particular mention to the name of Shri Sahdev Yadav.

Shri Sahdev Yadav told the House that as the report was prepared by him, it is not mandatory to include his name. The President told the House that name of Mr. Abraham Techi who become International Category-2 Referee recently was also not present in the report. The House congratulated the newly appointed International referees.

The House applauded the efforts of entire team of office bearers of Indian Weightlifting Federation and congratulated the President and Secretary General for remarkable achievements of Indian weightlifting. The House accepted the report of Secretary General.

The President welcomed the following members in the House:-

Shri K. Subramanya told the House that it was due to sincere effort of the President that India is able to participate in 2010 Commonwealth Games and able to raise huge financial penalty. He praised the efforts of Secretary General and stated that due to stringent Anti-Doping Policy in place, the Federation is able to save its skin. Donations were raised for the Federation by Secretary General and President from time to time.

Shri D. Chandrahas Rai told the House that State Associations have been received extended support from the National Federation in conducting dope test during State Championships. Periodic dope test were being conducted to keep in check the doping menace. Right approach of President & Secretary General reaped fruitful results for the game of weightlifting in last 4 years. Scheme of providing subsidized barbell sets by the Federation to State Associations were very helpful in promoting the sport at grass root level. Participation of Indian technical officials abroad was a regular feature in last 4 years and immensely benefitted to upgrade skills of Indian Technical Officials.

Shri Pal Singh Sandhu told the House that regular dope test were being conducted by the Federation during Inter-University, School Games, All India Police Games, Inter-Services Competition and Inter-Railway Competition from time to time.

The President told the House that Shri K. Subramanya was appointed as a referee for 2012 London Olympic Games from the Federation and further announced that there will be 3 referees from India for forthcoming 20th Commonwealth Games – Glasgow in 2014.

Shri Daniel Teli stated that affiliation / recognition letter in name of Arunachal Pradesh Weightlifting Association is required by them for submission in State Sports Council.

President assured him that necessary letter will be issued to their State from Federation office shortly.

The Meeting broke for lunch break for 30 minutes.

ITEM NO. 3:

ELECTION OF EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CONSISTING OF OFFICE BEARERS AND MEMBERS WEIGHTLIFTING INDIAN OF CONSTITUTION FEDERATION:-

The meeting resumed after taking lunch break and the House was briefed by Returning Officer, Observer from IOA and Observer from MoY&S about the modalities of newly laid guidelines of Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports about conduct of elections.

Returning Officer announced that nominations for posts of office bearers were received by him as below:-

President – only 1 nomination paper received against allocated quota of 1 post.

2. Vice Presidents - only 10 nomination papers received against allocated quota of

(iv) Shri Rakesh Gupta, Jt. Secretary, Indian Olympic Association and Observer.

The President announced that Item no. 3 will be taken after the lunch break under the supervision of above officials. Item No. 4 & 5 will be taken up before lunch.

ITEM NO. 4: AMENDMENT OF CONSTITUTION OF INDIAN WEIGHTLIFTING FEDERATION.

The Secretary General informed the House that following amendments have been accepted by the Executive Committee held at 8th November 2013 at New Delhi and has been presented in the General Council for approval and inclusion in the Constitution.

Shri Sunil Elangbam, Secretary, Manipur Weightlifting Association sought clarifications on the amendments from Shri Rakesh Gupta, Observer from Indian Olympic Association.

Shri Rakesh Gupta told the House that since he was appointed as an Observer from Indian Olympic Association and cannot take part in deliberations of the House but on request of the President he gave his personal opinion to the House that Constitution amendment of any National Sports Federation is an in-house activity and Indian Olympic Association will not interfere in any such proceedings.

After deliberations, the House passed the above amendments unanimously.

ITEM NO. 5: ANY OTHER BUSINESS WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR

Shri G.R. Beig told the House that last 4 years has been the golden era of weightlifting where athletes contributed with large number of medals, menace of doping was tightened.

 Secretary General – only 2 nomination papers received against allocated quota of 1 post.

From Serial no. 1 to 6 were elected unopposed since the nominations received by him are equal to or less than the allocated quota of respective posts.

The Returning Officer declared that there are 2 nominations received by him for the post of Secretary General and this post will be contested by secret ballot.

Voting by secret ballot took place for the post of Secretary General and after scrutiny results declared in favour of Shri D. Chandrahas Rai with majority of 27 votes against 20 votes in favour of Shri Sunil Elangbam. As such Shri D. Chandrahas Rai was declared elected to the post of the Secretary General of Indian Weightlifting Federation for the term 2013-2017. Complete formation of office bearers were declared as below:-
