### REPORT

# 27<sup>TH</sup> SENIOR WOMEN'S AND 46<sup>TH</sup> SENIOR MEN'S ASIAN WEIGHTLIFTING CHAMPIONSHIPS [QUALIFICATION EVENT FOR THE RIO 2016 OLYMPIC GAMES] HELD AT TASHKENT, UZBEKISTAN FROM 21ST TO 30TH APRIL, 2016

Competition:- 27th Senior Women's and 46th Senior Men's Asian Weightlifting Championships [QUALIFICATION EVENT FOR THE RIO 2016 OLYMPIC GAMES] was held at Tashkent, Uzbekistan from 21st to 30th April, 2016 under the Technical and Competition rules of International Weightlifting Federation (IWF) and Asian Weightlifting Federation (AWF).

Indian team consisting of 9 Senior Men + 7 Senior Women + 4 Coaches + 4 Support Staff + 1 Manager participated in these Championships. The Weightlifting Championships was held at Uzbekistan Sport Center, Tashkent.

Itinerary: The Indian team travelled in two groups to Tashkent – first group consisting of 13 members reached Delhi from Patiala on 18th April 2016 and 12 members stayed at Hotel Skyrich International, Karol Bagh, New Delhi. First group consisting of 13 members travelled by flight no. KC908 on 19th April 2016 from Delhi to Almaty at 1135 hours, then by flight no. KC911 from Almaty to Istanbul at 1755 hours and finally by flight no. HY 274 from Istanbul to Tashkent and reached on 20th April 2016 at 0520 hours.

Whereas second group consisting of 12 members reached Delhi from Patiala on 21st April 2016 and stayed back at Hotel Skyrich International, Karol Bagh, New Delhi. Second group consisting of 12 members travelled by flight no. KC908 from Delhi to Almaty on 22nd April 2016 and then by flight no. HY 764 from Almaty to Tashkent and reached Tashkent at 2320 hours on 22nd April 2016.

The team returned in 2 groups – first group consisting of 6 members returned on 27th April 2016 by flight no. HY422 at 1605 hours and second group consisting of 19 members returned on 1st May 2016 by flight no. HY 425 at 2330 hours.

The team is ferried by Bus provided by the Organizers to the designated Hotels.

Accommodation: The accommodation was provided at Hotel Uzbekistan.

<u>Competition</u>: The verification of final entries has been carried out on 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2016 and after verification, Asian Weightlifting Federation confirmed the participation of 262 athletes (161 Men + 101 Women) from 33 countries.

International Weightlifting Federation derived ranking places for Continental Qualification berths for 2016 Rio Olympic Games and as per practice, it was confirmed that India got 1 berth in women section by securing 3<sup>rd</sup> overall place with 100 points and 1 berth in men section with 129 points by securing 6<sup>th</sup> overall place in the qualification system respectively.
