2018 IWF SENIOR (MEN & WOMEN) WORLD WEIGHTLIFTING CHAMPIONSHIPS [QUALIFICATION EVENT FOR 2020 TOKYO OLYMPIC GAMES] HELD AT ASHGABAT (TURKMENISTAN) FROM 28 OCTOBER – 10 NOVEMBER 2018

Itinerary: The Indian team travelled from Sports Authority of India, Netaji Subhash National Institute of Sports, Patiala in two groups – first group consisting of 7 members on 31st October 2018 by flight no. H15019 departed New Delhi on 2:10 p.m. and reached Ashgabat on 4:50 p.m. and second group of 1 member on 7th November 2018 by flight no. H15019 departed New Delhi on 2:10 p.m. and reached Ashgabat on 4:50 p.m.

Competition:- 2018 IWF Senior (Men & Women) World Weightlifting Championships [Qualification Event for 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games] was held at Ashgabat, Turkmenistan from 28 October to 10 November 2018 under the Technical and Competition rules of International Weightlifting Federation (IWF).

Indian team consisting of 3 Men + 2 Women + 2 Coaches + 1 referee participated in these Championships. The Weightlifting Championships held at **Ashgabat (Turkmenistan)** was a well organized competition. The competition was held at Ashgabat Olympic Complex, Training Hall 2.

Accommodation: The accommodation to the Indian team members were provided at Olympic Complex Hotel, Ashgabat.

Competition: The verification of final entries was completed on 30th October 2018 and after verification, International Weightlifting Federation confirmed the participation of 604 athletes (321 Men + 283 Women) from 88 countries across the World.
