ACTC 2020-2021 for Weightlifting**

Minutes of ACTC 27th October, 2020: Indian Weightlifting Federation

The ACTC Meeting was held on Zoom platform under the Chairmanship of Shri Ravi Mittal, Secretary (Sports) on **27th October, 2020**, to consider ACTC budget request for Indian Weightlifting Federation (IWLF).

List of Members present in the meeting is at the end.

1. At the outset Secretary (Sports) stated that in view of developing the sport, IWLF should conduct more competitions at district and zonal level and also state championship competition should be conducted in every state.
2. DG, SAI Shri Sandip Pradhan also stated that in order to develop the grass root level athletes, there is a need to develop the coaches and IWLF should create a framework to develop the coaches.
3. Shri Sahadev Yadav, Secretary General, IWLF made following commitments, which are included as binding decisions as a part of approved ACTC calendar and budget: -

3.1 IWLF's main focus is on creating bench strength and early talent scouting at Junior and Youth level. Various sporting events such as Zonal, Inter Zonal, State and National Level Competitions and National Open Championship would be for identification of talent. IWLF would submit a self-contained proposal for financial assistance, along with the policy and structure of competition with in this regard **by 30.11.2020** to DG, SAI.

3.2 IWLF is also focused on developing the sports infrastructure and facilities.

3.3 IWLF would make its best efforts to achieve the following targets:

4. The calendar and budget were considered and approved with modifications pursuant to deliberations. The approved calendar and budget are placed at **Annexure 1 - 8**.
5. Other salient decisions are reproduced below:
- a. IWLF agreed to hire an Indian strength and conditioning cum mental trainer expert at a higher remuneration. In case of non-availability of an Indian strength and conditioning cum mental trainer expert, IWLF may hire a foreign expert. ***The budget to be booked under ACTC.*** Placed at Annexure - 6.
 - b. IWLF has agreed to hire a High-Performance Director (HPD) for Junior and Youth Talent Development. The HPD shall be in charge of all the TOPS NCOEs of Weightlifting and will oversee all activities of Junior and Youth in the NCOEs on rotational basis. ***The budget to be booked under Khelo India.***
 - c. Equipment
 - i. Consumable and Non-consumable equipment (Team Builder Software, Weightlifting shoes, Seminars / Motivational workshops and Gym machines for Patiala) for Elite athletes will be procured by the NSF at a total estimated cost of Rs. 1,34,66,226/- (Rupees One Crore Thirty Four Lakhs Sixty Six Thousand Two Hundred and Twenty Six only). ***The budget to be booked under ACTC.*** Placed at Annexure- 8.
 - ii. Consumable and Non-consumable equipment (Weightlifting Training Platform, Weightlifting Shoes, and Development of Ranking system web-based database) for Junior and Youth section will be procured by the NST at a total estimated cost of Rs. 95,80,000/- (Rupees Ninety Five Lakhs Eighty Thousand Only). ***The budget to be booked under Khelo India.***
 - iii. Equipments (consumables & non-consumables) to be procured in a time bound time manner by IWLF and for timely availability of equipments, IWLF should ensure the following:
 1. IWLF would procure in a competitive and transparent manner.
 2. For procurement of equipments and consumables budgeted amount to be released to IWLF in two equal instalments as Grant. First instalment to be released as an advance and subsequent instalments on submission of proof of procurement/utilisation certificate. IWLF would maintain inventory and record of equipments and consumables.
 3. IWLF would ensure that while procuring equipments and consumables, quantity should be used for getting competitive prices but inventory should not be allowed to accumulate.
 - d. The expenditure as mentioned under 'Coaches Development Pathway' and 'Referee Development Pathway' will be ***booked under the Human Resource Development Scheme (HRDS) fund.*** IWLF has committed to develop the NIS Diploma course and hire an International Coach for training and development of

Indian Coaches. IWLF to forward a self-contained proposal for the same in a time bound manner.

6. Total budget of **Rs.10,22,69,722/- (Rupees Ten Crores Twenty-TwoLakhs Sixty-Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-Two Only)** was approved for IWLF up to September, 2021. The breakup of amount is as follows:

In addition to the above, an amount of Rs. 95,80,000/- (Rupees Ninety Five Lakhs Eighty Thousand Only) would be allocated from *Khelo India* for procurement of equipment for NCOEs from the budget of the component "Support to National/Regional/State Sports Academies". The same shall be placed before the Departmental Project Approval Committee for release of funds.


