Sub: Participation of athletes training at NCOE, Aurangabad, Patiala, Lucknow, Bhubaneswar of States during 16th National Youth (Sub-Junior Boys & Girls) & 57th Men / 33rd Women Junior National Weightlifting Championships-2020-21 at Sports Authority of India, Netaji Subhash National Institute of Sports, Patiala from 9-13 August 2021 due to COVID-19 situation.

Dear All,

All State Associations are informed that athletes training at NCOE, Aurangabad, Patiala, Lucknow and Bhubaneswar can participate in subject Championships based on their best flash performance at NCOE centres.

Their performance will be taken by 3 Coaches at respective NCOE centres on a scheduled date(s) and will be sent to their States for entry during subject Championships. If the performances of NCOE athletes are higher than the athletes of States participating in Selection trials / State Championships, States are bound to give entry to NCOE athletes as first preference, however, NCOE athletes performing higher will not get any medals from their State for higher performance. It is submitted that NCOE athletes will be encouraged to participate in National Championships from their respective states with par performance.
