**Item No. 7: Opening of new bank account with a Nationalized Bank of Indian Weightlifting Federation:-**

The Secretary General informed the House that after merger of Andhra Bank with Union Bank of India, the services of the Union bank has become below par and Indian Weightlifting Federation office is finding it difficult to initiate basic financial activities with the Union Bank of India on strict timelines at elsewhere branches in Noida. The Secretary General proposes to open a new bank account with a Nationalized Bank, preferably near the secretariat office at Noida besides having an account with Union Bank of India. Moreover, the balance of new bank account will be taken in the Annual Balance Sheets of Indian Weightlifting Federation.

The entire House approved to the proposal of opening of new bank account in a Nationalized Bank for Indian Weightlifting Federation where banking activities will be easily handled at fast pace. The entire House empowered the President and Secretary General to initiate paper work related to opening of new bank account for Indian Weightlifting Federation. The Bank account will be operated by President, Secretary General and Treasurer as per past practice.

- (2) The Secretary General informed the House states of Uttarakhand and Madhya Pradesh are not complying directions of Indian Weightlifting Federation and weightlifting activities come to a standstill in these States. **Item No. 9: Election of Executive Committee / Council consisting of office bearers and Members as per Constitution of Indian Weightlifting Federation:-**

Shri Narinder Paul Kaushik, Judicial Officer (Retd.), Delhi District Courts, Returning Officer took the Chair along with Shri Rakesh Gupta, Joint Secretary, Indian Olympic Association (IOA) – Observer IOA and started the proceedings of the Election of Executive Committee / Council consisting of office bearers and Members as per Constitution of Indian Weightlifting Federation.

The Returning Officer told the House that 27 State and Union Territories with voting rights have sent the names of their Accredited Members and maximum 54 members can exercise their power of right to vote in the Elections from those 27 State and Union Territories. On the present day, 27 State Units are participating in the Elections of Indian Weightlifting Federation with total strength of 50 members out of 54 members were present in the House.

- (iii) Indian Weightlifting Federation has issued notice of Annual General Council Meeting on 9<sup>th</sup> September 2021 along with agenda items and Specimen Form for Delegates of affiliated States and Union Territories to publish the names in Form 1.
- (iv) The Election Schedule was sent to the office of Indian Weightlifting Federation for publication on its website [www.iwlf.in](http://www.iwlf.in) which was done on 17<sup>th</sup> September 2021.
- (v) Publication of Electoral College and other relevant forms were published on its website from time to time.
- (vi) Nomination were filed by the members of Indian Weightlifting Federation on 25<sup>th</sup> September 2021 in my presence and kept in a sealed box and after opening the box on 25<sup>th</sup> September 2021 afternoon, list of nominated members in Form 3 was published and after scrutiny List of Validly Nominated Candidates in Form 4 was published on the website of Indian Weightlifting Federation on 25<sup>th</sup> September 2021.
- (vii) The date of withdrawal of nomination forms was fixed as 28<sup>th</sup> September 2021 but no withdrawal form was received by me. On 29<sup>th</sup> September 2021, List of Contesting Candidates as per Form 6 was published on the website of Indian Weightlifting Federation.
- (viii) The Annual General Body meeting cum Electoral Congress of the Indian Weightlifting Federation was held at Hotel Aarkay Palace, Sector 44, Noida, Uttar Pradesh. Total members present in the house were 50.
