**Sub.: Mandatory registration of athletes on the online portal for issuance of Athlete ID Cards upto 15<sup>th</sup> May 2022 for participation during IWLF Youth (Boys & Girls) and Junior (Men & Women) National Weightlifting Championships-2022-23 at Nagercoil (Tamilnadu) and IWLF Youth (Boys & Girls) and Junior (Men & Women) National Weightlifting Championships-2023-24 at Kerala.**

Dear All,

**This is second and last reminder** to all the affiliated States and Union Territories Associations and once again informed that in order to participate in the forthcoming IWLF Youth (Boys & Girls) and Junior (Men & Women) National Weightlifting Championships-2022-23 at Nagercoil (Tamilnadu) and IWLF Youth (Boys & Girls) and Junior (Men & Women) National Weightlifting Championships-2023-24 at Kerala the athletes have to mandatorily register themselves for issuance of ID Cards **on or before 15<sup>th</sup> May 2022.**

**Those athletes who fail to apply for new ID cards online within the stipulated deadline of 15<sup>th</sup> May 2022 will not be eligible to compete during the above Championships.**

Kindly widely publicize the circular amongst your district association, registered gyms and weightlifting clubs so that all athletes will know about the new regulation formulated by Indian Weightlifting Federation.

No last minute request for extension of deadline for registration of new athletes will be entertained in any manner whatsoever.
