Welcome: The Secretary General started the meeting by welcoming all members in the House and briefed about the emergent situation in which the meeting was called by Indian Weightlifting Federation for the proposed amendments in the Constitution which are not to harm the interest of any individual but to tow in line with the directives formulated in the National Sports Development Code adopted by Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports.

The President, Indian Weightlifting Federation congratulated everybody for the medals won by Indian athletes during 2022 IWF Junior and 2022 IWF Youth World Weightlifting Championships concluded recently.

The President further informed the House that Sports Authority of India and Khelo India Division congratulated Indian Weightlifting Federation for successful conduct of the Khelo India University Games-Bangalore and Khelo India Youth Games-Panchkula.

Item No. 1: Confirmation of Minutes of Executive Committee Meeting held at Bengaluru on 24th April 2022:-

The secretariat office informed the House that Athlete ID Card deadline for applying has been extended till 30th June 2022 and athlete will receive their ID cards online by 15th July 2022. No fresh cards will be made in the month of July 2022 which means those athletes who have registered upto the new deadline of 30th June 2022 or those who possess old physical id cards are eligible to participate in forthcoming National Weightlifting Championships for Youth and Junior upto 2023-24.

The Secretary General informed the House that Minutes of Executive Committee Meeting held at Bengaluru on 24th April 2022 was circulated to all the members on 6th June 2022. All the members have confirmed the receipt of the Minutes and passed it unanimously.

Item No. 3: Any other business:-

- (i) The President told the House that those Executive Members who will are not part of either Technical Officials or Team Officials will be covered by Indian Weightlifting Federation with to and fro 2nd AC rail fare and 2 days boarding & lodging stay (free of cost) during the National Weightlifting Championships in future.

The entire House acknowledged the gesture of President and thanked the Chair for making such provision.

- (ii) The President further informed the House that Indian Weightlifting Federation has nominated Shri Birendra Prasad Baishya, M.P. for the post of Vice President, International Weightlifting Federation for which the electoral congress was held at Tirana, Albania from 23-25 June 2022. But during the time of election, Shri Baishya suddenly withdrew his name from the post of Vice President and Executive Board Member – IWF. The entire House objected to this move and told the President that it is not correct as some other member in his place can be fielded by Indian Weightlifting Federation for getting representation from India.

Shri Paramjit Singh told the Chair to issue showcause notice to Shri Birendra Prasad Baishya being the Member of Parliament for such behavior.

Shri Rajneesh Bhaskar requested the Chair to nominate himself in any International body wherever the election will be conducted in future.

After deliberations, the entire House unanimously approved and empowers the President to nominate himself or any other Executive Board Member(s) of Indian Weightlifting Federation to represent India during International Weightlifting Federation, Asian Weightlifting Federation and Commonwealth Weightlifting Federation and other Regional / Continental Federations as the case may be.

- (iii) The President informed the House that Manager accompanying the Indian team abroad for International competitions were now covered at Full Cost to the Government and Indian Weightlifting Federation has been sending managers who are International Referees (criteria set forth by MYAS and Sports Authority of India).

All technical officials will be given equal chance to represent India as Managers. The President emphasized that young brigade of technical officials will be given exposure as Referees for International Championships in future.

The President informed the House that Shri K. Suryanarayana has been nominated as Manager of Asian Youth and Junior Weightlifting Championships at Tashkent in July 2022 whereas Shri S.H. Anande Gowda as Manager accompanied the Indian team to Mexico during 2022 IWF Youth World Weightlifting Championships.

- (iv) The President informed the House that lot of RTI has been coming to the office of Indian Weightlifting Federation for the anomalies in documents of Telangana Weightlifting Association. RTI applicants has been approaching Central Information Commission for the non-production of documents by Indian Weightlifting Federation which is not in possession of such documents in the matter of Telangana Weightlifting Association which is a shame since the State bodies are not putting their house in order and Indian Weightlifting Federation are bearing their brunt in public eye.

Shri Rajneesh Bhaskar told Shri D. Sailoo to comply with the directions of RTI Act of Government of India and submit every document duly signed and stamped under Association's seal.

- (v) The President informed the House that 36th National Games will be hosted by Gujarat. He further addressed Shri Mayur Patel, Executive Member, Indian Weightlifting Federation, Secretary, Gujarat to make suitable preparations for the Games with compliance of technical and competition rules of International Weightlifting Federation. The Competition Manager will coordinate with Shri Mayur Patel for local liaison.

The criteria for participation for National Games was explained by President, Indian Weightlifting Federation to all the members.

- (vi) The President informed the House that first Edition of Women Weightlifting League Ranking tournament – Youth, Junior and Senior was successfully conducted by Himachal Pradesh Weightlifting Federation at Rainbow International School, Nagrota Bagwan, Himachal Pradesh. The Event was even above the level of Khelo India Youth and University Games. The technical conduct of the competition was at par with International standards. The hospitality of the Host Organization was beyond imagination. The first edition of the Women League ranking tournament has set an example for other State Associations.

The President told the House that second edition of Women League tanking tournament is proposed to be held at Modinagar, Uttar Pradesh whereas the

Secretary General wishes to conduct the third / fourth edition of Women League ranking tournament at Bangalore.

The President, Indian Weightlifting Federation informed the House that participation of women athletes to be kept mandatory in Women League ranking tournament otherwise the athletes will not be allowed to participate in any National Championships in future.
