## **IWLF SELECTION POLICY FOR**

## ASIAN GAMES-2022, INTERNATIONAL EVENTS-2023 AND OLYMPIC GAMES-2024

- I. This document lays down the guidelines and conditions for selection of the Indian weightlifting team for International events in 2023, Asian Games-2022 and Olympic Games-2024.
- II. For the purpose of selection, only results achieved by a weightlifter at following competition shall be considered:-
  - 1. Athletes participated during National competitions in 2022 & 2023.
  - 2. Athletes participated during International competitions in 2022.
  - 3. Selection trials to be held at SAI, NS, NIS, Patiala in 2023.
  - 4. Athletes who have complied with submission of Whereabout Information on ADAMS portal of WADA within the stipulated deadline.
- III. The maximum number of lifters that can be selected will be as under:-
  - 1. For Asian Games 1 in a weight category Eligible weight categories Men (7 nos.) – 61 kg, 67 kg, 73 kg, 81 kg, 96 kg, 109 kg and +109 kg, Women (7 nos.) – 49 kg, 55 kg, 59 kg, 64 kg, 76 kg, 87 kg and +87 kg.
  - 2. For Olympic Games 1 in a weight category Eligible weight categories -Men (5 nos.) – 61 kg, 73 kg, 89 kg, 102 kg and +102 kg, Women (5 nos.) – 49 kg, 59 kg, 71 kg, 81 kg and +81 kg.
  - 3. For other International competitions -2 in a weight category. However, overall a maximum of 20 lifters can be selected based on the recommendations of Selection Committee of Indian Weightlifting Federation.
- IV. The best performance from the competitions listed in point II above would be considered. Based on this best performance, the Selection Committee formed by Indian Weightlifting Federation shall decide the final list of participants after comparing the performance with that of ranking of Asia, Commonwealth and World standards in the respective group and weight categories.
- V. Minimum and maximum age criteria of athletes will be as per Technical & Competition Rules of International Weightlifting Federation.
- VI. Only Senior national campers and NCOE athletes are eligible to participate in competitions.
- VII. In case of any dispute or for any matter not covered in this policy, the decision of the Selection Committee of Indian Weightlifting Federation shall be final.
