IWLF SELECTION POLICY / ASIAN GAMES 2022

1. This document lays down the guidelines and conditions for selection of the Indian Weightlifting team for the Asian Games-2022.
2. For the purpose of selection, only results achieved by a weightlifter at the following competitions shall be considered:-
 - i. 2021 Tokyo Olympic Games
 - ii. 2021 IWF World Championships
 - iii. 2022 Singapore International Championships
 - iv. 2022 IWF World Championships
 - v. IWLF Selection trials held in 2022 / 2023
3. The minimum qualifying standards (MQS) for Men shall be the 10th best and for Women shall be 8th best lift by the Asian in 2022 IWF World Ranking List. This correspond to the following:-

4. The maximum number of lifters that can be selected in a weight category is two. However, overall a maximum of 14 lifters can be sent to the Asian Games – 2022 (7 Men + 7 Women). In case more weightlifters, meet the MQS than the maximum permissible slot at the Asian Games, then the highest ranked lifter when compared to the lifts in the 2022 IWF World Ranking List, would be sent.
5. In case of any dispute or for any matter not covered in this policy, the decision of the Selection Committee shall be final.
