IWLF SELECTION POLICY FOR INTERNATIONAL EVENTS-2023 & 2024

- I. This document lays down the guidelines and conditions for selection of the Indian weightlifting team for International events in 2023 & 2024.
- II. For the purpose of selection, only results achieved by a weightlifter at following competition shall be considered:-
 - I. Athletes participated during National competitions in 2022 & 2023.
 - 2. Athletes participated during International competitions in 2022.
 - 3. Selection trials to be held at SAI, NS, NIS, Patiala in 2023 & 2024.
 - 4. Athletes who have complied with submission of Whereabout Information on ADAMS portal of WADA within the stipulated deadline.
 - 5. Weight categories as per Technical & Competition Rules of International Weightlifting Federation, Asian Weightlifting Federation and Commonwealth Weightlifting Federation.
- III. The best performance from the competitions listed in point II above would be considered. Based on this best performance, the Selection Committee formed by Indian Weightlifting Federation shall decide the final list of participants after comparing the performance with that of ranking of Asia, Commonwealth and World standards in the respective group and weight categories.
- IV. Minimum and maximum age criteria of athletes will be as per Technical & Competition Rules of International Weightlifting Federation.
- V. Only Senior national campers and NCOE athletes are eligible to participate in competitions.
- VI. In case of any dispute or for any matter not covered in this policy, the decision of the Selection Committee of Indian Weightlifting Federation shall be final.

IWLF SELECTION POLICY FOR PARIS OLYMPIC GAMES – 2024.

PARIS 2024 OLYMPIC QUALIFICATION RANKING as of 22 September 2023

The OQR includes ONLY one (1) athlete per Olympic bodyweight category per NOC (Member Federation) with the highest Totals (in kilograms) achieved in any of the Qualification Events.

The OQR contains the official results of the following qualifications event(s) already concluded:

- 2022 IWF World Championships (Bogotá, COL) / 05-16 December 2022
- 2023 Pan-American Championships (Bariloche, ARG) / 27 March 01 April 2023
- 2023 European Championships (Yerevan, ARM) / 15-23 April 2023
- 2023 Asian Championships (Jinju, KOR) / 05-13 May 2023
- 2023 African Championships (Tunis, TUN) / 14-18 May 2023
- 2023 IWF Grand Prix I (Havana, CUB) / 08-18 June 2023
- 2023 IWF World Championships (Riyadh, KSA) / 04-17 September 2023

Please note that the OQR will be updated after each qualification event.

In the circumstance that two, or more, athletes record the same Total in the same Olympic bodyweight category they shall be ranked in order of which achieved the result first, using equivalent Greenwich Mean Times (GMT) to decide such if necessary.

NOTE

Results achieved by athletes in non-Olympic bodyweight categories will be included in the OQR in the respective Olympic bodyweight category that incorporates their weight as indicated in the below table (e.g., athlete's total in M67kg achieved at the 2023 IWF Grand Prix I, will be included in the Olympic bodyweight category of M73kg). The highest Total achieved by each athlete at qualification events will be counted towards their overall ranking, taking into
