The details of the IWLF Coaches Upgradation Programme (Level 1) are as under for your kind information and necessary action:-

Level 1 – Basic Coaching Course

This level introduces the fundamentals of weightlifting coaching, focusing on basic anatomy, movement patterns, safety guidelines, and correct techniques for foundational lifts. Participants are trained to coach beginners, ensure proper warm-ups, and prevent injuries.

Eligibility: Any individual interested in coaching

Course Fee: ₹15,000/- per participant + GST (as applicable)

Duration: 10–12 days

In this regard, it is hereby informed that **only the Level 1 Coaching Course** is permitted to be conducted by the affiliated **States / U.T.s / Departments** in association with the Indian Weightlifting Federation.

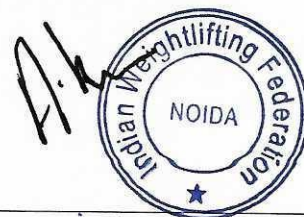

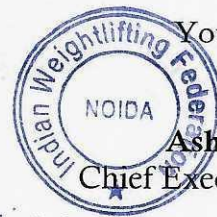

The concerned State / U.T. / Department shall be responsible for providing the following:-

1. Air tickets from the nearest airport to the course location for the Coach Educator and accompanying translator
2. Local transportation (SUV) for airport transfers and daily travel during the course period
3. Air-conditioned classroom with adequate seating arrangements
4. Public Address (P.A.) system with cordless microphones and speakers
5. Projector and screen for presentations, along with printer and white sheets
6. Teaching stationery (pens, notepads, folders, index files, etc.)
7. Boarding and lodging (single occupancy) for the Coach Educator in a **4/5-star hotel**, with a ceiling of **₹2,500/- per day** towards food expenses
8. Boarding and lodging for the course translator, with a ceiling of **₹1,000/- per day** towards food expenses
9. Complimentary T-shirts for participants and staff as per **IWLF-approved design**
10. Printing of participation certificates as per **IWLF-approved design and template**
11. Backdrop banner displaying the course title and relevant details

All affiliated **States, Union Territories, and Departments** interested in conducting the **Level 1 Coaching Course** are requested to submit their proposal to the Indian Weightlifting Federation well in advance for approval and scheduling.
